Legislation

- ▶ CalRecycle administers Oil Payment Program
- ▶ PRC 48600 - California Oil Recycle Enhance Act
- ▶ \$11 million provided annually
- ▶ To Local Governments
- ▶ For Used Oil and Filter collection programs



PRC §§ 48690 and 48691

Applicants must have a used oil collection program which includes one of the following:

1. One CCC for every 100,000 residents, **or**
2. Used Oil Curbside Collection - at least once a month, **or**
3. Provides a combination of used oil curbside collection and ensures one Certified Used Oil collection center for every 100,000 residents, **and**
 - Have a public education component of used oil recycling opportunities.

Return Un\$pent Money by August 15

Return Unspent Funds

- Apply for Cycle in May
- Cycle begins July 1st each Year (24 month cycle)
- Payments received in April
- Return Unspent Funds by August 15

Extension Authorization

Guideline Change

- Previously it required a 90 day notice prior to June 30th to be considered.
- The section that allows recipients to request an extension of their cycle term is no longer included in the Guidelines.
- If an extension request is received CalRecycle management will discuss the request.

Tablet Devices

Public Education and Outreach

- \$500 Maximum
- Typically 7 inches or more (measured diagonally)
- Data plans are ineligible
- Additional costs can be spent on accessories for charging, item protection and security

HHWIE Yahoo Group - Online

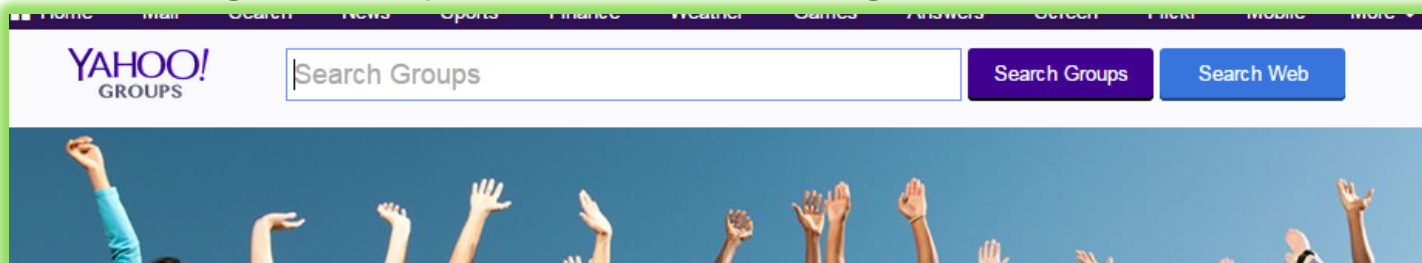
The purpose of the HHWIE Yahoo Group is to give household hazardous waste professionals the ability to communicate and share ideas online.
