

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE ADOPTING ZERO WASTE AS A GOAL IN ORDER TO ELIMINATE WASTE AND POLLUTION IN THE MANUFACTURE, USE, STORAGE, AND RECYCLING OF MATERIALS

WHEREAS, Zero Waste is a philosophy and visionary goal that emulates natural cycles, 6 where all outputs are simply an input for another process. It means designing and managing 7 materials and products to conserve and recover all resources and not eliminate discharges to 8 land, water, or air that do not contribute productively to natural systems or the economy; 9 10 WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management (CIWM) Act of 1989, Assembly Bill 939, required cities and counties to reduce, reuse and recycle (including 11 composting) solid waste generated in the state to the maximum extent feasible before any 12 incineration or landfill disposal of waste, to conserve water, energy and other natural resources, 13 14 and to protect the environment;



Guidelines For Filter Exchange Event

Guidelines for City of Oceanside

Used Oil Filter Exchange Events

- Stores will display and distribute O'Reilly approved posters and flyers prior to the events.
- Store needs to have the filter collection drums and oil collection tank emptied immediately prior to event.
- Stores will designate one employee to assist City Staff set up City of Oceanside booth near used oil collection tank and assist in the collection of used filters and used oil.
- Store will supply paper towels and a tarp large enough to place under collection area to prevent oil spillage into parking lot and sidewalk if needed.
- Store will provide empty cardboard boxes or equivalent for the recycling of filter boxes.
- City Staff will issue coupons to authorize each customer to exchange the
 allotted amount of filter they can receive. The number of filters will be in an
 event specific color to avoid customers to change the number. O'Reilly staff
 will inspect the coupons for any tampering and give the customer only the
 authorized amount. O'Reilly staff will keep coupons and give them to City
 Staff at the end of the event.
- Price of exchange filters will not exceed \$13.99.
- Maximum amount of individual events will not exceed \$3000.00 unless previously authorized by City Staff.
