### Legislation



The California Public Resources (PRC) code §48600 et seq. describes the California Oil Recycle Enhance Act, which, among other things, provides up to

\$11 million annually in payments to local governments for implementation of local used oil and filter collection programs. The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, (CalRecycle) is responsible for administering the Oil Payment Program (OPP).



### PRC §§ 48690 and 48691

To receive payment Applicants must have a used oil collection program which includes one of the following:

- 1. Ensures there is one Certified Used Oil Collection Center for every 100,000 residents.
- 2. Provides used oil curbside collection at least once a month.
- 3. Provides a combination of used oil curbside collection and ensures one Certified Used Oil collection center for every 100,000 residents is available, and
- Has a public education component that informs the public of locally available used oil recycling opportunities.

### Guidelines...



- The Guidelines describe the Application and administrative process to implement the OPP program. They are consistent with the intent of the legislation and are designed to streamline the administrative requirements within a fiscally sound framework.
- Payment recipients are responsible for ensuring that expenditures are appropriate and that proper internal documentation is maintained.




# Un\$pent Funds

  - Coupons
  - Filters
  - Creepers
  - Oil Drain Containers
  - Oil Drain Wrench



### **Tablet Devices**

The purpose of these devices would be for Public Education and Outreach.

- \$500 Maximum
- Typically 7 inches or more (measured diagonally)
- Additional costs can be spent on accessories for charging, item protection and security for events.
