SB 254 (Hancock) 2013

- Passed by Legislature and signed by the Governor in September 2013.
- Governor signed SB 254, but required cleanup legislation in the next session (SB 1274).
- Required the formation of an Advisory Committee to be part of the Mattress Recycling Organization (MRO) with members appointed by the Director of CalRecycle.
- Required the retailers, beginning by July 1, 2014, to give a consumer the option to have a used mattress picked up, at no additional cost, at the time a new mattress is delivered or be provided with an opportunity for free drop-off of the used mattress.
- Required manufacturers, retailers, and renovators of mattresses to register with the MRO on or before January 1, 2015.
- Requires the MRO, by July 1, 2015, to develop a plan for recycling used mattresses in the state and to submit the plan to CalRecycle.

SB 254 (Hancock) 2013 - Continued

- Focus on reimbursement to local governments for illegal dumping related to mattresses.
- Ensure that facilities accepting mattresses as part of the program, accept at no cost to the customer.
- Allow the MRO to establish up to 2 fees to consumers at the retail counter.

Advisory Committee

- The Advisory Committee membership:
 - 4 from local government
 - 2 from environmental groups
 - 2 from the solid waste industry
 - 3 from collection, processing, and recycling
 - 2 from sleep products retail industry
- The 3 components:
 - Collection In the street, Facilities
 - Transportation
 - Processing/Recycling
- Committee meetings
- 9 Identified issues:
 - Illegal Dumping
 - Collector Incentives
 - Consumer Recycling Fees

- Payments to Solid Waste Facilities
- Waste Hierarchy
- RFP Development

- Servicing Rural California
- Education & Outreach
 - Solid Waste Survey
