# Used Mattress Recovery and Recycling Act

- Supports statewide goal of at least 75% by 2020
- Reduce illegal dumping, increase recycling, reduce public agency costs for end-of-life management
  - Chapter 388, Statutes of 2013 [Hancock, SB 254] established statewide Mattress Stewardship Program.
  - Chapter 371, Statutes of 2014 [Hancock, SB 1274] clarified definitions, report submittals, and record keeping requirements.



### Scope

Recycling charge at point of sale for a mattress and its foundation

#### Mattress

resilient material or combination of materials that is enclosed by a ticking... intended for or promoted for sleeping upon

#### Foundation

 ticking-covered structure used to support a mattress or sleep surface





### Scope



#### Excludes

- Mattresses manufactured by Prison Industry Authority and purchased by the state
- unattached mattress pads/toppers
- sleeping bags or pillows
- juvenile products
- water beds
- air mattresses



### Statutory Responsibilities

### CalRecycle

- Appoint MRC Advisory Committee
- Approve plans, annual reports, budgets
- Approve the mattress recycling charge
- Post compliant manufacturers and renovators
- Enforcement
- Set baseline and recycling goals



### Statutory Responsibilities

- Mattress Recycling Organization
  - Develop plan, budgets, annual reports
  - Propose mattress recycling charge
  - Provide education and outreach
  - Maintain records on compliant manufacturers
  - Reimburse CalRecycle



# Mattress Recycling Organization

- ► MRO must be certified by department
- Advisory Committee
  - 13 members appointed by Director http://www.calrecycle.ca.gov/mattresses/Stewardship.htm



## **Mattress Recycling Plan**

- On or before July 1, 2015:
  - MRO must submit plan to CalRecycle for recycling used mattresses in CA. Plan needs to:
    - Coordinate activities with existing used mattress collection and recycling programs
    - □ Provide sufficient funding for MRO to carry out the plan



### Plan Requirements



- Objectives consistent with CA's solid waste management hierarchy
- Increase used mattress diversion
- Reduce illegal dumping
- Increase quantity of used material



# Plan Requirements: Education and Outreach

- Outreach efforts and education to consumers, manufacturers, and retailers
  - MRO to include examples of educational materials
  - Provide information about self drop-off
  - Develop processes to collect from low-income communities



### Retailer Used Mattress Take-back

- July 1, 2014
  - Must offer consumers used mattress pick up at time of new mattress delivery
  - Can contract out to third party
  - Reserve the right to refuse used mattress if determined contaminated or a risk





### **Mattress Recycling Budget**

- ▶ On or before July 1, 2015
  - MRO must submit budget to CalRecycle, including Mattress Recycling Charge
  - Sufficient to fund revenue requirements in budget
  - Flat rate
  - No more than two different charges based on different mattress sizes



### Plan and Budget Approval

Within 90 days of receipt:

- Mattress Recycling Plan
  - CalRecycle must approve, disapprove, or conditionally approve
- Budget
  - CalRecycle must approve or disapprove



### Plan Implementation

- Within 90 days after approval or conditional approval, MRO will implement the plan
- Each manufacturer, renovator, retailer, or distributer that sells a mattress to the ultimate end user shall add the recycling charge to mattress price





### Reporting

### By July 1, 2017, and each year thereafter:

- MRO submits Annual Report
- Recyclers and renovators must report:
  - Number of mattresses received and recycled/renovated
- Solid waste facility operators
  - Number of mattresses recycled, renovated, and disposed



### **Enforcement**

- Civil Penalties and/or:
  - Revoke mattress recycling plan and require MRO to resubmit
  - Remove manufacturer or renovator from website list of compliant parties





# **Enforcement: Compliance**

- ▶ July 1, 2014
  - Retailers must offer consumers used mattress pick up at no additional cost
- January 1, 2015
  - Manufacturers, renovators, and retailers must be registered with the MRO
- January 1, 2016
  - ▶ Retailer shall not sell, distribute, or offer for sale
  - Manufacturer or renovator shall not sell, offer for sale, or import in CA or to a distributor or retailer
