# GO-BIZ UNIT: BUSINESS INVESTMENT SERVICES

Works with companies to expand their presence in California by streamlining the site selection process and offsetting the cost of doing business with the use of local, state and federal incentives.



#### **GO-BIZ UNIT: SMALL BUSINESS**

Provides small business assistance through interagency projects, informational workshops, and direct advocacy. Also maintains a comprehensive list of resources for small business technical assistance, financing, and state procurement.



#### **GO-BIZ UNIT: PERMIT ASSISTANCE**

Provides permit streamlining for jobcreating projects. The permitting team also administers the state's electronic on-line permit assistance center, CalGOLD.



### GO-BIZ UNIT: INNOVATION & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Administers the state Innovation Hub (iHub) program which includes 12 iHubs stretching from Chico to San Diego. These regional innovation clusters bring together government, academia, and business to further enhance California's entrepreneurial ecosystem.
