Legislation

- CalRecycle administers Oil Payment Program
- PRC 48600 - California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act
- Up to \$11 million provided annually
- To Local Governments
- For Used Oil and Filter collection programs



PRC §§ 48690 and 48691

Applicants must have a used oil collection program which includes one of the following:

1. One CCC for every 100,000 residents, **or**
2. Used oil curbside collection - once a month, **or**
3. A combination of used oil curbside collection and one CCC for every 100,000 residents, **and**
 - Have a public education component of used oil recycling opportunities.

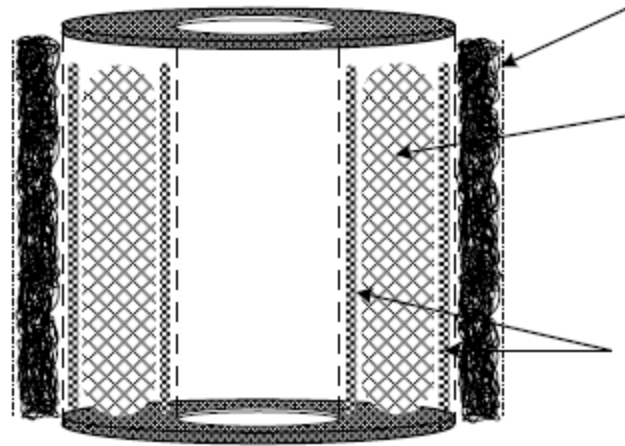
