FACILITY RULES

1. PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE
2. Allowable drop off amount for all other material is 5 Gallons or 50 lbs max per vehicle.
3. Allowable drop off for fluorescent tubes is 12 max.
4. Limit of one trip per day.
5. No Unknown material accepted.
6. We do not accept: smoke detectors, explosives, ammunition, radioactive waste, mixed materials, garbage, infectious & biologically active material, railroad ties, or remediation waste.
7. Must have ID and proof of Residency.
8. No commercial waste is accepted without a scheduled appointment.
