Facts about Oil Recycling

What we do with used oil plays an important role in balancing our needs for convenient transportation with our need to maintain a clean environment.

YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE TODAY BY RECYCLING YOUR USED OIL!

Did you know used oil can be recycled?

- Used oil does not burn after it has been drained from an engine.
- Oil does not water wash. It simply becomes dirty as it circulates. This water and contaminants are drained from the fuel and used oil is returned to a full, wet, usable fuel.
- Used motor oil can be made into home and business oil or used in road paving, asphalt, and other products.
- Recycling and re-refining of used motor oil saves energy. When you bring one quart of used motor oil, household oil, or used oil to a recycling center, you are saving one gallon of oil that had to be drilled from the ground.
- Recycling just 2 gallons of used oil can generate enough energy to run the average household for 24 hours.

What can be made with re-refined oil?

- Used motor oil makes great motor oil.
- Re-refined oil can be made into fuel for heating.
- Used oil gets recycled every day for homes, schools, and other uses.

Why Recycle Waste Tires?

Waste tires are considered one of the most problematic types of trash found in landfills. Waste tires become an environmental and health hazard as they collect water and debris, making them a breeding ground for insects, particularly disease-carrying mosquitoes.

- While this has been known from an early, no alternative methods of disposal are needed.

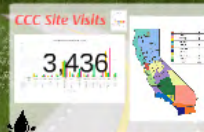
