RMDZ Specifications

In order to qualify for an RMDZ loan, your project/company must be located within a Zone (see map); must divert non-hazardous recycled materials from landfills; and must receive recycled materials generated in California.

If you do not currently qualify for a loan, you may qualify for business assistance. Contact your local Zone Administrator or RMDZ program staff and we'll discuss your needs and how you may become qualified for a loan.



Current Efforts Online Map


 Click on zone for CalTrans map of region with transportation corridors.




