- CalBIS was launched in 2003 when Technology,
 Trade & Commerce Agency (TTCA) was eliminated.
- Memorandum of Understanding was developed between TTCA and Employment Development Department to have CalBIS staff reside at EDD.
- In 2005, CalBIS relocated to LWDA, reporting to Secretary and Deputy Secretary of Employment and Workforce Development.
- Currently four professional staff provide statewide client services.
