



What is SharePoint?

- Developed by Microsoft to integrate with Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel, Outlook, etc.)
- Hosted and managed by CalRecycle on Cal/EPA web and database servers.




Why Did We Do This?

- Issues with “Findability” for documents and e-mail messages.
- Provide long-term and accessible storage of RMDZ documents, presentations, newsclips, event info, and Program announcements.
- Provide the most up-to-date information available from CalRecycle that may not really be of interest to the public.



How Does This Help us?

- The public website hosted by CalRecycle at <http://www.calrecycle.ca.gov/RMDZ/> gives an amazing overview of the whole program but is generalized for the public.



How Does This Help us?

- The ZIRS Database is used to for CalRecycle to receive and process specific information about Zones and businesses.
