Ortigalita Power Company \$1,350,000 Merced County RMDZ

Gasification system that will convert wood into a synthetic natural gas ("syngas" or "producer gas"). The syngas will feed into a specially modified natural gas genset to produce electricity on the grid.



Environ Strategies \$1,637,500 City of Chino RMDZ

Anaerobic digestion biomass power facility that will process and convert food waste into biomethane gas, for electrical generation on the grid .



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Plastic Energy – Hanford \$2,000,000 Greater South San Joaquin RMDZ

The project will take post-consumer plastics (primarily types 3 thru 7) and catalytically convert them into gasoline and low-sulfur diesel fuel.

Air Permit Challenge:

- Environmental Group PVC MRF material may contaminate the feedstock.
- Equip. change to turbine rather than piston engines and the reduction of plastic melters from three to one.
- The project required reconsideration in light of CEQA
