# Grant Program Overview Tire Incentive Program (TIP)

#### Ø What is it?

 This competitive grant program provides a reimbursement (as an incentive payment) to eligible businesses that use crumb rubber in eligible products or substitute crumb rubber for virgin rubber, plastic, or other raw materials in products that are sold

### **Ø** Which businesses are eligible?

- Manufacturers or waste tire processors that produce (or will produce) an eligible product for themselves or on a contract basis for others
- Manufacturers of calendered rubber sheeting products
- Rubber compounders



# Grant Program Details Tire Incentive Program (TIP)

### **Ø** How much money is available for grant awards?

 Grant awards range from a minimum of \$25,000 to a maximum of \$500,000

### **Ø** What are the requirements?

- Applicants must be California-based or incorporated in another state qualified to do business in California with a manufacturing facility in California
- Applicants must have been operational for at least three years
- All crumb rubber must be from California-generated waste tires processed in California (no out-of-state processed material)
- Product must contain a minimum of five percent crumb rubber (or end-of-life material) and may include tire buffings



# Grant Program Details Tire Incentive Program (TIP)

### **Ø** Funding Allocation

• FY 2017/18: \$2,608,858

#### Ø Reimbursement

Reimbursement on a quarterly basis

#### **Ø** Grant Term

- Approximately two years
- Grant term begins with the Notice to Proceed
- Grant term ends April 1, 2020

# **Ø**Reporting

Quarterly Progress and Final Reports are required



# Grant Program Incentives Tire Incentive Program (TIP)

### **Ø** Incentive Categories and Amounts

Incentive Category	Incentive per pound (net of returns)
1. New/Existing TDP	10 cents for total crumb rubber or end-of-life material used in eligible products sold
2. Feedstock conversion (products currently made with virgin rubber, plastic or other material)	40 cents for total crumb rubber used in eligible products sold
3. Fine ( <u>&lt;</u> 50) mesh	50 cents for total crumb rubber used in eligible products sold

# Grant Program Overview TDA Grants

## **Ø**Eligible Applicants

- All California local government entities (including cities, counties, special districts, Joint Powers Authorities (JPA), and school districts
- All California State agencies (including offices, departments, bureaus, and boards)
- The University of California, the California State University, or California Community Colleges
- Qualifying Indian Tribes
- Private, for-profit entities and non-profit organizations



# Grant Program Overview TDA Grants

#### **Ø**Available FY 2017-18 & FY 2018-19:

• \$850,000 (each year)

### **Ø**Grant Amount (maximum):

\$350,000 or \$750,000 for "a very large project"

# **Ø**Eligible Projects/Categories

- Lightweight fill/Retaining wall backfill
- Vibration mitigation
- Low Impact Development (LID)/Storm water management
- Landfill applications



# Grant Program Overview Rubberized Pavement Grants (formerly called RAC Grants)

### **Ø**Eligible Applicants

- Local governments (cities and counties)
- Other local governmental agencies (park districts and JPAs)
- State agencies\*
- Qualifying Indian Tribes



<sup>\*</sup>limited to Class 1 bikeways, greenways, and disability access at parks
