1. Leads and Resources

CalRecycle will Partner with

The way it works:

Business calls one of us.

CalRecycle, you or both of us scope out their needs – usually via a conference call, then provide customized resources.

Permitting

Manufacturing Materials (Feedstock) Sourcing

Tire grinds or coffee grinds, oyster shells, #3-7 plastic paper, crushed concrete, cullet, food waste, various other organics, pallets, #1 PET, Mattresses, Inerts, Sand, Gravel, Soil, Sheetrock, Windshield Glass, Textiles, and the list goes on.....

Equipment Analysis

CalRecycle technical staff will analyze equipment/process to determine to weigh in on technology being marketed.
