Why World Café

- Cafe assumptions
 - The knowledge and wisdom we need are already present and accessible
 - Collective insight – evolves from honoring unique contributions, connecting ideas, listening in to the middle, noticing deeper patterns and questions

World Café at A Glance...

- **Three (3) progressive rounds** of conversation with each round addressing one question.
- At the **end of each round**, participants are invited to **move to a different table**.
- **New question discussed** while linking and connecting ideas with previous conversation rounds. Notes on the table will enable participants to have a **visual memory of the conversation**.

World Café Guidelines

- Focus on what matters
- Listen to understand
- Connect ideas
- Play, doodle, draw
- Listen together for patterns, insights, and deeper connections

One More Thing....

- Before getting started, each group will need to identify a **table host** (not facilitator) who remains at the table during the 3 conversation rounds to:
 - **Welcome** newcomers
 - Share the **main ideas, themes, and questions**
 - Encourage guests to **link and connect ideas** (using the notes on the table)
