Loan Amount	 \$2,000,000 or 75% of total project cost, whichever is less. Matching funds of at least 25% of the total project. Borrower can receive more than one loan for either loan program. Must result in additional diversion using the same or different type of feedstock, manufacturing process, or end product Borrower cannot to exceed \$5 million in total principal outstanding Cannot exceed \$3 million in RMDZ loans. 	 \$2,000,000 or 75% of total project cost, whichever is less. Matching funds of at least 25% of the total project. Borrower can receive more than one loan for either loan program. Must result in additional diversion using the same or different type of feedstock, manufacturing process, or end product Borrower cannot to exceed \$5 million in total principal outstanding, including RMDZ.
