- -Business association who's goal is to Further the Interest of Businesses
- -Helps create the BEST Community to live, work and do business.
- Nearly every city, town or region has one.Many different sizes and Influence

- Membership funded. Can also receive municipal funding and grant funding.
 Can be Political - CAUTION
- –Interacts with Businesses, Agencies, Non-Profits, Municipal Officials and Elected Representatives

- –Promotes business, provides a conduit between businesses and municipalities
- -Source for Demographics and regional information & acts as a welcoming committee
- –Promotes tourism
- -Community members also include schools, special districts

Assisting & Attracting Businesses, Including Manufacturing and Industrial

- -New and Interested Businesses contact the Chamber of Commerce for community and regional information
- –Sets up meetings with officials as required
- -Can assist & provide support through regulatory process

- -Links the company with myriad resources, potentially includes RMDZ
- –Provides assistance with media and press releases
- -Becomes a connection between the company and the community

Establishing a Relationship with the Chamber of Commerce

- -Contact the President, CEO or Executive Director of the Chamber
- -Schedule a meeting to discuss the RMDZ program, CalRecycle, and Local Programs
- -YOUR membership is covered under the municipality's membership

- –Focus on the benefit to businesses
- –If they have factory tours, join them
- -Be willing to speak at events and meetings about the program
- -Trade Shows and other Outreach
